

A BYLAW TO PROHIBIT THE DISCHARGE OF FIREARMS

The Council of the Town of Strasbourg, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. Subject to Section 2, no person shall discharge any gun or other firearm, air-gun, or spring gun, bow and arrow or any class or type thereof within the Town Boundaries.
2. The provisions of Section 1 do not apply to police officers or other persons authorized by Council to discharge firearms within the Town boundaries.
3. The Council may authorize an officer of the Town, in writing, to issue to a recognized gun club or similar organization a permit, in writing, entitling it to operate for the purpose of supervised target practice or similar activities in the Town.
4. No such club or organization as set out in Section 3 hereof, shall operate at any time without such a permit, and the person in charge shall produce and exhibit his permit when requested to do so by any municipal constable, licence inspector, or other authorized person.
5. The boundaries of the Town of Strasbourg shall mean the legal boundaries containing the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of 23-24-22-W2, NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of 24-24-22-W2, all of 25-24-22-W2 and the E $\frac{1}{2}$ of 26-24-22-W2.
6. Any person found guilty of an infraction of any of the provisions of this bylaw shall be liable to the penalties provided in the general penalty bylaw of this Town.

Bylaw No. 1/49 is hereby repealed.
