

TOWN OF STRASBOURG  
BYLAW NO. 228/92  
GENERAL PENALTY BYLAW

The Council of the Town of Strasbourg, in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. This Bylaw shall be known and referred to as the "General Penalty Bylaw" of the Town.
2. Section 3 shall apply only to an infraction of a bylaw of the Town for which no other fine is provided and which, such Bylaw states, shall incur the fines herein provided.
3. Subject to the provisions of Section 2, any individual found guilty of an infraction of a bylaw of the Town of Strasbourg, passed by authority of The Urban Municipality Act, shall be liable to a fine of not more than \$2,000 and costs for every offence.
4. Subject to the provisions of Section 2, any corporation found guilty of an infraction of a bylaw of the Town of Strasbourg, passed by authority of The Urban Municipality Act, shall be liable to a fine of not more than \$5,000 and costs for every offence.
5. General Penalty Bylaw No. 154/82 passed September 10th, 1982 is hereby repealed.
