

BYLAW NO 342/14 CIVIC ADDRESSING BYLAW

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF STRASBOURG, IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN TO PROVIDE FOR THE NUMBERING OF HOUSES AND OTHER BUILDINGS.

The Council of the Town of Strasbourg in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- 1. This bylaw shall be referred to as the Civic Addressing Bylaw.
- 2. A uniform system of numbering houses and other buildings is hereby established by the Town of Strasbourg and is shown on the attached map identified as Schedule "A", appended hereto and forming a part of this bylaw.
- 3. A separate number shall be assigned for each feet of frontage.
- 4. Each house or building shall bear the civic number assigned to the frontage on which the front entrance is situated.
- 5. In the case of a corner lot, the number on the front entrance will apply to the street of which the narrow portion of the lot faces.
- 6. In the case that a house or building is occupied by more than one family dwelling unit or business, each separate front entrance of said house or building shall bear the same number extended with a letter of the alphabet beginning with the letter "A" and proceeding with as many as are required.

E.g. 239A Mountain Street

7. In the case that a house or building is occupied by more than one family dwelling unit or business, and the entrance to said building is shared, each business or family dwelling unit shall bear the same number prefaced with a unit number then a dash beginning with number "1" and proceeding with as many as are required as identified in Schedule "B," appended hereto and forming a part of this bylaw.

E.g. #1-200 Mountain Street

- 8. Numerals indicating the official number of each house or building or each front entrance shall be posted in a manner as to be visible from the street on which the property is located.
- 9. The Administrator shall be responsible for maintaining the numbering system and shall keep a record of all numbers assigned under this bylaw.

- 10. Any person who does not comply with this bylaw will be billed the total cost incurred by the Town to erect the property signage or alternately this cost will be added to the owners tax bill.
- 11. All existing numbers of houses and other buildings not now conforming to the provisions of this bylaw shall be changed to conform to the system herein adopted.



- 1. As per Clause 7 of Bylaw 324/14 known as the Civic Addressing Bylaw, the civic address of the Town of Strasbourg and R.M. of McKillop No. 220 Administration Building located at 200 Mountain Street shall now be as follows:
 - a. Town of Strasbourg Office #1-200 Mountain Street
 - b. R.M. of McKillop Office #2-200 Mountain Street
 - c. R.C.M.P. Strasbourg Detachment Office #3-200 Mountain Street
