BYLAW NO. 361/15 PREDATOR CONTROL OFFICER BYLAW

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF STRASBOURG, IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN, TO APPOINT A PREDATOR CONTROL OFFICER

The Council of the Town of Strasbourg in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- 1. The Council of the Town of Strasbourg is hereby authorized to appoint a Predator Control Officer for the Town of Strasbourg.
- 2. The appointment shall be terminated by either the Council of the Town of Strasbourg or the Predator Control Officer.
- 3. The Predator Control Officer is hereby authorized to hunt animals listed in clauses 4(1)(e) to (I) of *The Wildlife Regulations*, 1981 within 500 metres of any building in the municipality without the consent of the owner of the building.
- 4. The Predator Control Officer is hereby authorized to hunt animals other than those animals listed in clauses (4)(1)(e) to (l) *The Wildlife Regulations, 1981* within 500 metres of any building in the municipality without the consent of the owner of the building.
- 5. In residential areas, the shooting of animals shall not occur between dusk and 7:00 a.m., unless the animal is judged to be an immediate danger to the public.
- 6. At year end, an honorarium of \$250.00 shall be paid to the Predator Control Officer.
- 7. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the final date of passing by Council.
