Thank you to everyone who attended the Town Hall Meeting on June 16 at the Strasbourg Memorial Hall. There were many Town residents in attendance and a lot of good issues were discussed. We will be having meetings such as this on an annual basis.

The Bylaw Enforcement Officer (BEO) program has been implemented in the Town. The Council appreciates the cooperation of the ratepayers with the BEO as he enforces the bylaws. Please be aware that any complaints made to the Town Office regarding animals or nuisances need to be given to the Administration in writing with the copies being signed and dated. Complainants' personal information will never be given out by the BEO or Administration.

The Free Landfill Weekend held on the May Long Weekend was well utilized by the Town residents. There were 103 loads taken to the Landfill and over 80 different households using the service. Thank you to those who provided proper identification to the Landfill operator demonstrating your civic address. # FIRE INSURANCE - \*\*PLEASE READ\*\*

Since the Town of Strasbourg has a volunteer fire department, a \$3,000.00 call-out fee is charged when the volunteers respond to a call. These call-outs are not paid through our taxes, unlike in large cities and some other smaller municipalities.

While insurance is always optional, it is <u>strongly</u> <u>recommended</u> that you check your current house or business insurance policy to make sure that it contains an endorsement for firefighting call-out fee coverage. The annual cost is minimal, and it will cover false alarms, carbon monoxide calls, or any other emergencies that the fire department would respond to.
