# RECYCLING CHEAT SHEET

## Single Stream (Blue Bin)

- Non-soiled cardboard, office paper, newsprint, junk mail, magazines, and catalogues
- Shredding (only recyclable item to be bagged; cannot be confetti shredding, only strips)
- Plastics numbered 1 through 7 (no food containers labelled #1, no plastic wrap or plastic bags)
- Tin and aluminum cans
- Household glass (food and beverage containers)

Other than shredding, all recyclable items should be loose in the bin

#### **SARCAN**

- Beverage containers (aluminum cans, plastic bottles, glass bottles, juice cartons, refillable beer bottles)
- Milk products (milk, buttermilk, cream, fluid coffee cream, lactosefree milk products, drinkable yogurt)
- Household paint
- Electronics (computers, printers, TVs, audio equipment, video equipment, cameras, telephones)
