MUNICIPAL UPDATE

Beginning in August, the Strasbourg Memorial Hall will be under construction as we repair the southwest foundation. The repair will take approximately two to three months. The Hall can still be used and accessed, but the kitchen will be unavailable during that time. The Library will still be accessible, but patrons will have to use the south entrance off the alley instead of the regular entrance off the parking lot.

Later this fall, the Hall is going to become a licensed facility. Alcohol will be available for all events held at the Hall if requested at the time of booking. The bar will be managed by volunteers and it will be a fundraiser for local organizations, as well as for the facility itself. Going forward, organizations and renters will not be required to purchase their own liquor permit or need to manage their own liquor for their events - it will be taken care of by us!

The Town is also in the process of upgrading the technical equipment within the Upper and Lower Hall, including an electronic screen for the stage, a wireless projector, and an upgraded TV for the Lower Hall to better host funerals, presentations, etc. With these upgrades we are hoping to encourage more events to be held at the Hall, including movie nights, live streaming of sports games, concerts and musical entertainment, and much more.

Also this fall, we will be advertising for our Legacy Tree program within the Strasbourg Lions Park and other green spaces. You will have the ability to donate funds towards new trees for our community. Details on the project will be available on our Facebook page, website, and in the Spotlight this fall.

Lastly, a reminder that trailers and campers are not to be parked on the street unhitched. They can be attached to a vehicle on the street, but only for a maximum of 72 hours. This is the case with all vehicles being parked on the street. Thank you for your attention to this matter.


