#5 - Did You Know...

That the Town of Strasbourg uses, on average, 67,670 imperial gallons of treated water per day or 25,173,100 imperial gallons annually. Of the annual total, 550,000 gallons is made up of bulk water sales to non-Town residents.

To put that into perspective, the annual amount of water the Town uses would fill 46 Olympic-sized swimming pools. Or to put it another way, if you turned on a standard garden hose and let it run continuously, it would take more than 24 years to use that much water!

#6 - Did You Know...

That on average, to cut grass for the entirety of the Town, it takes approximately 70 hours of labour? In addition, there is another 40 hours of labour for whippersnipping.

In total, there is 327,000 square metres of grass to cut, or over 81 acres. During the busy grass growing season, this is equivalent to cutting half a quarter section of land once a week, but we're using zero-turn mowers.

While there are always slight variations, the general grass cutting route for the Town in order of priority is as follows: Lions Park, Cemetery, Green Space, Museum, Memorial Hall, Highway ditches, Erickson Road ditches, Maple Street subdivision and associated municipal reserve grassy areas, empty Town-owned residential and commercial lots, Railway Avenue grassy areas, Rec Centre, Sports Park, Shop and Water Treatment Plant, lagoon road, gravel road ditches, back alleys, Transfer Station, and finally, the Elevator road.

DID YOU KNOW CONTINUED...

#7 - Did You Know...

We are one of the very few communities in Saskatchewan that has a gravity-fed system for our wastewater and storm water? This means that the wastewater and storm water flows naturally to the lagoon without the help of lift stations. This is incredibly important as we do not rely on any source of power to manage our sewer and storm water system. In the event of a power outage, our sewer and storm water system will always function, and you will never have to worry about sewer back-ups in your home from the wastewater not being pumped away. However, there is always the possibility that significant, intense rainfall could cause back-ups or flooding as our storm water system can only remove so much water at one time – nothing is perfect. It's always important to have a backflow prevention valve installed on your sewer line for these potential occurrences.

Since our sewer and storm water system is gravity-fed, we have no way of telling as to how much sewage and storm water enters our lagoon daily. Our main lagoon is seven (7) acres and our evaporation cell built in 2017 is 51 acres. We have a lot of capacity for many years to come.

Fun fact - our lagoon grows corn and tomatoes! Corn kernels and tomato seeds are not digestible by humans, so they make their way to lagoon, which becomes a perfect growing environment for corn and tomato plants!

Our Council Chambers and Administration Office have been newly renovated. Staff and Council are very excited to have our office space and boardroom converted back to how it was over 10 years ago. We want to thank Murray Kondratiuk for all his work renovating the Council Chambers and Administration Office. We have a more secure, functional, and professional-looking space for us to conduct business in. If you haven't seen our upgraded office and boardroom yet, stop by to check it out!

A very special thank you goes out to Terry Osborne for the beautiful art donation to our new space! We are incredibly proud to display it. Coming soon - a Community Quilt created by the Between Friends Quilt Guild will also find its permanent home in our new boardroom.

Our Council Chambers is available to rent - \$50/half day or \$75/full day. Not-for-profit and volunteer organizations can still use the room free of charge as before. The room now includes a projector (that displays on a large blank wall), a powered table with plug-ins, a kitchenette with a fridge, Keurig machine and coffee, and various kitchen supplies. The Town of Strassbourg owns a public use AED machine, which is located in the vestibule at the Last Mountain Pioneer Home (700 Prospect Avenue). The LMPH is open 24/7, which means that the AED machine can be accessed by anyone at anytime.

There are several other AED machines located around the community, but they are specific to a particular facility and are only available when the facility is open.

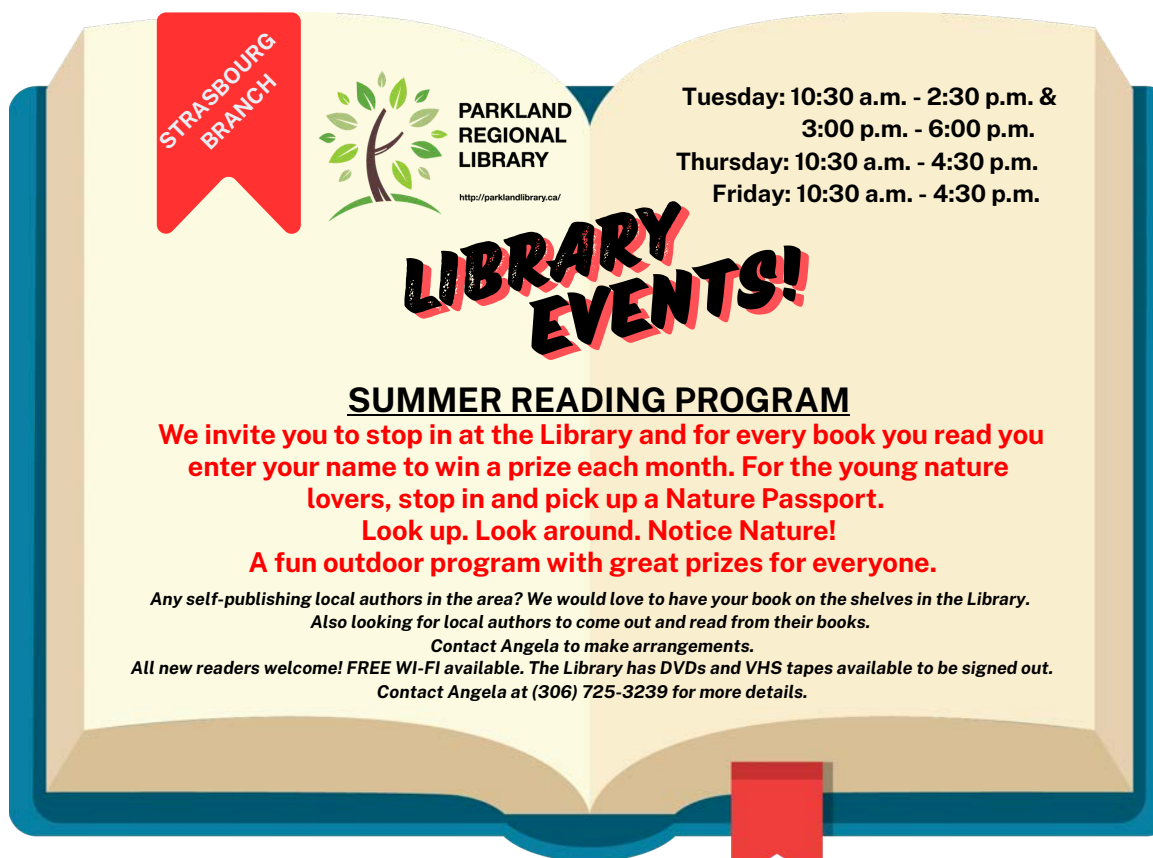

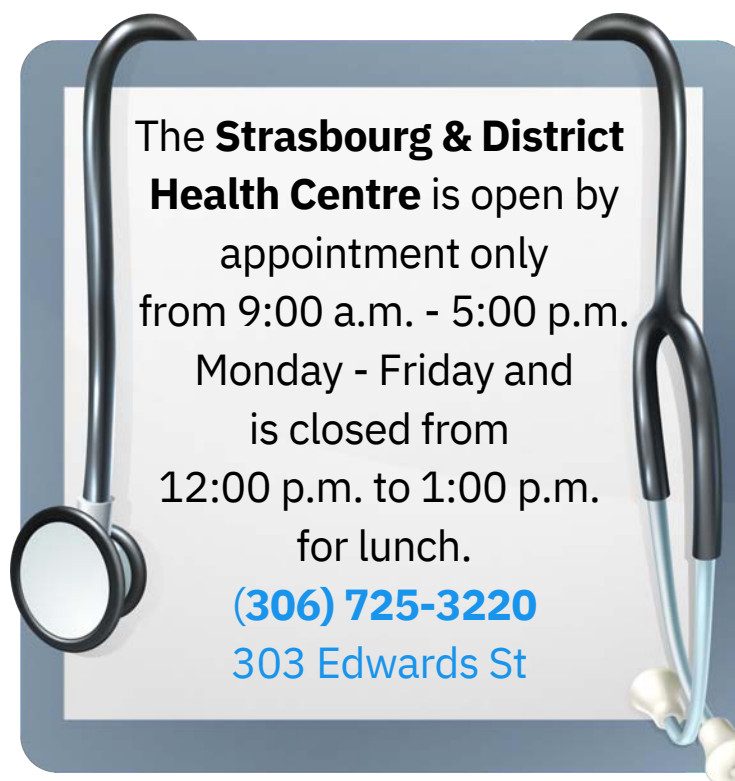

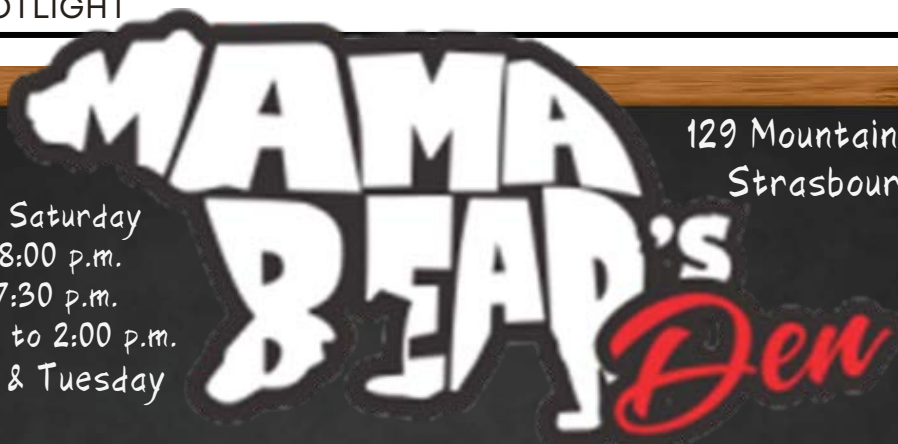
