RAZZLE DAZZLE THRIFT SHOP UPDATE

On May 15, 2025, Razzle Dazzle celebrated our one year anniversary. Donation and support within and outside of the community have exceeded our expectations and we are grateful for the initial support that got our project off the ground.

In 2024, we were able to donate:

- \$1,263.00 towards the purchase of the LUCAS machine for the Strasbourg EMS.
- \$200.00 to Bulyea and William Derby Schools towards their lunch programs.
- Afghans and uniforms to staff at the Last Mountain Pioneer Home.
- Items to the family that lost their home and belongings in a house fire.
- \$1,500.00 to the Strasbourg Ministerial for Christmas Hampers to provide for families that needed some extras.

In 2025, we have donated:

- \$2,000.00 to the Strasbourg & District Fire & Rescue towards the purchase of thermal imaging cameras.
- \$500.00 to the Bulyea Hall Committee to provide needed funds for the community hall.
- \$250.00 to the Graduation Class of 2025 towards the construction of the concrete sidewalk from the parking lot to the front door of the school.

On Facebook, we have a request form for non-profit organizations to apply for extra funding for their projects.

Overall, we have had a successful year with our dedicated volunteers and have been able to provide a consistent service to the Town and surrounding area in keeping with our mandate and vision to reduce, reuse, and recycle.

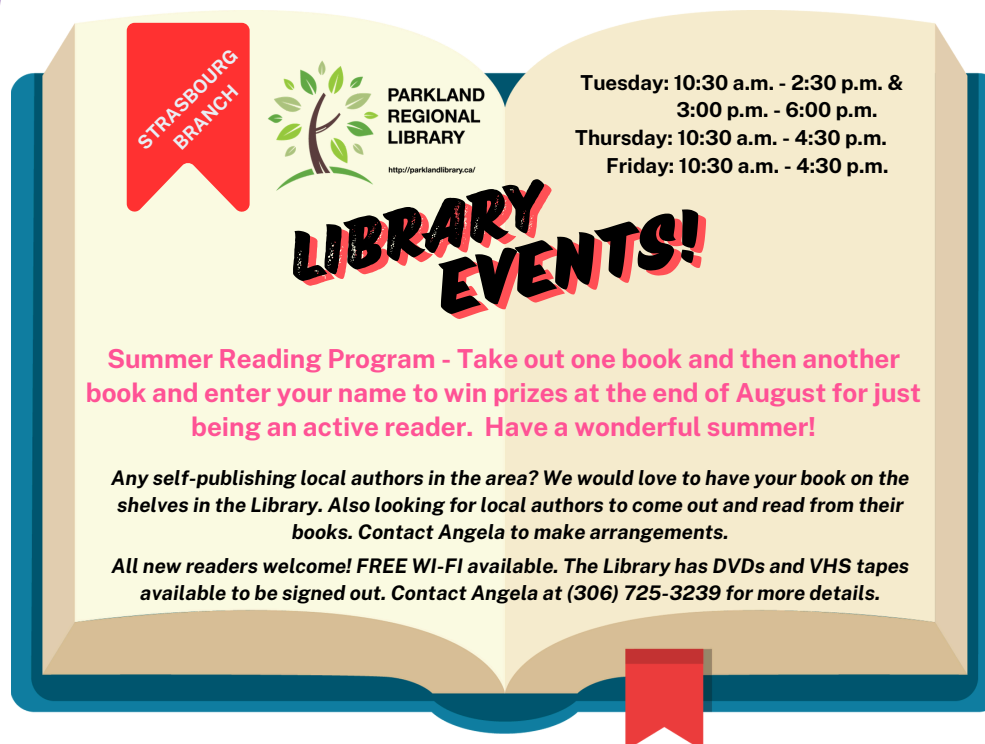

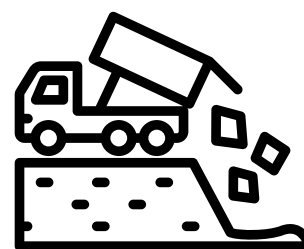
