On May 15, 2025, Razzle Dazzle celebrated our one year anniversary. Donation and support within and outside of the community have exceeded our expectations and we are grateful for the initial support that got our project off the ground.

In 2024, we were able to donate:

- \$1,263.00 towards the purchase of the LUCAS machine for the Strasbourg EMS.
- \$200.00 to Bulyea and William Derby Schools towards their lunch programs.
- Afghans and uniforms to staff at the Last Mountain Pioneer Home.
- Items to the family that lost their home and belongings in a house fire.
- \$1,500.00 to the Strasbourg Ministerial for Christmas Hampers to provide for families that needed some extras.


In 2025, we have donated:



Strasbourg Housing Authority Senior Housing has one bedroom, one bathroom bungalow style units available for immediate occupancy, for independent living. All units have a full kitchen (fridge and stove) and laundry (washer & dryer). They are approximately 550 square feet, with no need to worry about home repairs, cutting the grass, or snow removal. Excellent living environment for your peace of mind.

We do allow one small, neutered cat or dog. No smoking of any kind is allowed in your unit.

Strasbourg is a full-service community, with many social opportunities to be as active as you would like.

Rent is based on your income, and tenants are responsible for their SaskPower. Water, sewer, and heat are included in the rent.
