CENSUS 2026 IS UNDERWAY IN THE TOWN OF STRASBOURG

What is the Census?

The Government of Canada conducts a Census every five years. The census is how the government enumerates, or counts, the population and gathers important information that helps different levels of government make plans and decisions for the future.

Census data can help researchers and policymakers answer important questions based on expected population sizes. These include how many schools are needed in an area, what level of staffing is required for emergency services, whether there are enough hospitals, whether changes are needed to public transit or roads, and whether there is enough affordable housing in low-income areas.

How Does it Impact Strasbourg?

For more real-world application, the provincial and federal government provides **funding to municipalities based on population numbers**.

Currently, the Town of Strasbourg receives approximately \$359 per counted resident per year. For a smaller community like Strasbourg, every resident matters. If residents are not counted, the Town can lose significant funding:

- 1 uncounted resident = approximately \$359 lost per year
- 10 uncounted residents = approximately \$3,590 lost per year
- 25 uncounted residents = approximately \$8,975 lost per year

Over a 5-year census cycle, that could mean:

- 10 missed residents = over \$35,900 lost
- 25 missed residents = over \$44,875 lost

After the last census in 2021, the Town of Strasbourg's population decreased by twelve people (from 800 to 788), when it fact it should have increased by at least twenty people based on the list of people who did not fill the census out. Essentially, over the course of the last five years, the Town has lost out on **\$57,440** in funding. Coupled with this, the Town's SaskLotteries funding that is allocated to the Strasbourg Recreation Board, has lost over \$3,000 per year because of the population decrease, or **\$15,000** over the past five years.

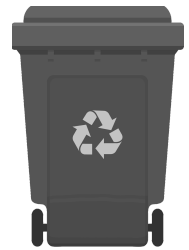

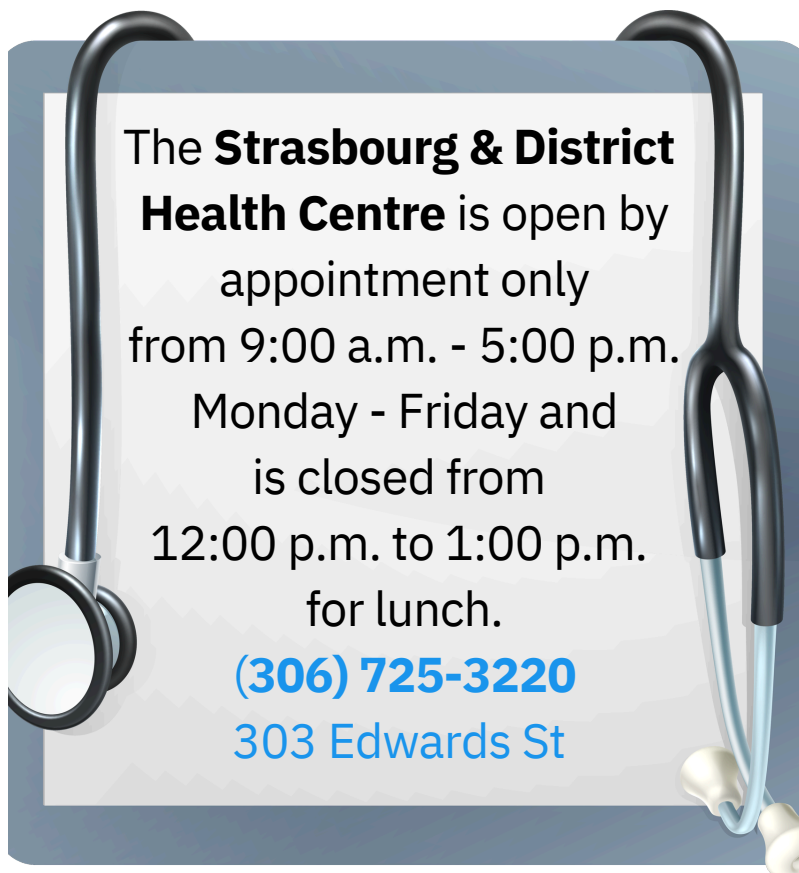

While this may not seem like a lot, **\$72,440** is a significant loss to our community, and those funds would have went right back into Town infrastructure and recreation programming.

What do you need to do?

Census forms have been delivered to homes throughout the area and residents are encouraged to complete their census forms as soon as possible. If your household was missed, please contact **Carol Schultz, Census Crew Leader** at **(306) 725-7122** and assistance will be provided to help you complete a census form.

Enumerators are scheduled to begin visiting households on **May 22**, focusing on residences where census forms have not yet been completed. Residents are asked to help make their work easier by completing the census online right away if possible. Anyone who needs assistance can call the number above and help will be provided. For those who do not complete the census online, enumerators will provide a paper form to be filled out. Once completed, the paper forms will be collected by the Enumerator and mailed to Ottawa.

Thank you to everyone for caring about the place we live and for recognizing how fortunate we are to call this area home. A special thank you also goes out to the enumerators for the amazing work they have done in helping complete this large undertaking.
