HELP US GROW STRASBOURG ADOPT A BOULEVARD TREE!

The Town of Strasbourg will be planting new boulevard trees this season — and we're inviting residents to help them thrive! The Town was fortunate to receive a grant from the Federal Canadian Municipalities (FCM) Growing Community Canopies Fund, which has provided funding to plant 40 boulevard trees around the community!

Newly planted trees need consistent watering during their first two years to establish strong, healthy root systems. We're looking for residents willing to help care for the tree(s) planted on the boulevard adjacent to their property.

🌿 What Are We Planting?

This year's plantings may include:

- Willows
- Lindens
- Oaks
- Maples
- Smaller ornamental varieties

Species selection will depend on nursery availability and approved planting sites. Nursery trees will be between 6' to 8' tall when initially planted.

💧 What's Involved for Watering?

Watering Guidelines:

- 15–20 gallons (55–75 litres) is needed per watering
- Watering needs to happen once per week in normal conditions or twice per week during hot, dry, or windy conditions
- Watering can be skipped if significant rainfall is received (1 inch / 25 mm or more)
- Water should be applied slowly at the base of the tree to soak the root ball deeply instead of light, frequent watering.

💧 When to Water:

- May through September with the most critical months being June, July and August
- Watering can continue into early fall if things are dry but watering can stop before freeze-up

🌱 Why It Matters

- Consistent watering in Year 1 is essential. You will need to continue to water in Year 2 as watering during dry periods supports continued root growth
- After two years, the trees will be generally established
- Most tree losses happen because watering stops too early – not because of winter

By helping care for a boulevard tree, you're:

- Enhancing our community's beauty
- Increasing property value
- Providing shade and environmental benefits
- Contributing to Strasbourg's long-term urban forest



🌳 Interested in Helping?

If you're willing to help water and monitor a boulevard tree near your property, please contact the Town Office. You will receive a cancellation on your utility bill for any water overage you may have during the third and fourth quarter utility cycles.

Please note: Tree varieties and locations are at the final discretion and approval of the Town of Strasbourg, as not all properties have suitable space for boulevard trees.
