## EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS WEEK

### MAY 3-9, 2026

**BE PREPARED. KNOW YOUR RISKS**

Emergency Preparedness Week is an annual, Canada wide, awareness initiative and an opportunity for you to take action to ensure you're prepared to protect yourself, your family and your community during an emergency. As this year's theme suggests, we all need to understand the potential risks in our own lives and communities and get prepared to support our families and communities.

At last year's Emergency Preparedness Day in Strasbourg, your local Strasbourg Emergency Measures Organization (EMO) took a poll of attendees, and their main risk concern was fire, both residential and wildfire, with a smaller group mentioning water supply and security as a concern as well. Town Council has also identified risks around medium to long term power outages, especially during winter.

In 2026, your EMO Committee is doing a comprehensive review of **all** potential risks for our Town and will be asking for public input and feedback when we have the draft document compiled. Strasbourg has already addressed some risks with investments in equipment and software to communicate and mitigate the potential emergencies:

- In 2017, Town invested in an automatic Diesel Generator to ensure Town water systems are always powered and operational. This ensures a potable water supply in most emergency conditions and an adequate fire water supply to allow the Strasbourg & District Fire and Rescue (SDFR) team to respond effectively within Town limits and beyond.
- In 2025, the Town launched a new website with a built-in notification app "**Strasbourg Connect**" that allows for mass notifications to all residents registered in the app, such as Boil Water advisories. Your EMO Committee strongly encourages everyone with a cell phone/personal computer (PC) to register for "**Strasbourg Connect**" as soon as possible.

## EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS WEEK

- The Province also provides cell phone/PC apps for real-time alerts about emergencies in and around our area and your EMO encourages you to have these on your cell phone/PC as well:
  - “**SaskAlert**” can notify you immediately about emergencies that may affect your safety.
  - The “**Saskatchewan Evacuation App**” requires you to pre-register on-line and gives residents a way to provide our community with important information required where an evacuation is necessary. Residents’ information collected through the application is shared with Strasbourg’s leadership/EMO and is also used by the Province to ensure resources are available during an emergency.
- In late 2025, at the recommendation of your EMO Committee, the Town purchased a portable PTO driven generator capable of powering the entire Strasbourg Memorial Hall during an extended power outage. The recent repairs required to the Hall included a generator hook up that will let your EMO set up in the Hall for operations in extended power outages, such as an Emergency Warming Station in winter for residents who have no other heating options.

The best way to support yourself and your community is to become self-sufficient for a minimum of 72 hours in the initial phase of any emergency and have a personal plan for staying or leaving depending on the circumstances. **More people managing the first 72 hours without requiring assistance, means more capacity and resources are freed up at the Community, Provincial and Federal levels, to address and manage the emergency directly while also helping those who are unable to help themselves.**

### Know the Risks & Make Plans to respond accordingly

- Family Communication
- List of Emergency numbers
- Evacuation plans

### Prepare/purchase a 72 Hour Emergency Kit - [Check and refresh twice yearly (seasonal)]

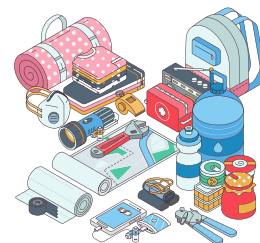
- Food & Water
  - A manual can opener
  - Plastic plates/cups/cutlery
