

# TOWN OF STRASBOURG RECYCLING CHEAT SHEET



## Single Stream (Blue Carts)

- ✓ Cardboard, Boxboard, Office Paper, Newsprint, Junk Mail, Magazines and Catalogues, Shredding (needs to be bagged)
- ✓ Plastic Containers, Plastic Milk Jugs, Milk and Juice Cartons (no "Clam Shell" type food containers labelled #1. No oil containers or chemical jugs. Remove all lids and caps)
- ✓ Tin, Aluminum & Glass (Rinse all items. Labels can remain on)
- ✗ **Items NOT Accepted:** Clamshell containers, lightbulbs, plastic bags and stretch wrap, wood and metal scrap, diapers, styrofoam and plastic utensils, hoses and rubber items, toys & clothing, food and garbage, furniture, hazardous chemical containers, ceramic dishes, auto parts

Other than shredding, all recyclable items should be loose in the bin

## Other Recyclables

Metal & Appliances - Drop off at the Town Transfer Station during set open times from May to October

Lightbulbs & Light Fixtures - Drop off at K-Light Recycling at 1665 St. John Street, Regina

- ✓ Foam packaging
