#8 - Did You Know...About the Town's Cemetery History?

The Old Strassburg Cemetery (locally known as "One-Eye") was Strasbourg's first cemetery, located at SW 20-24-21 W2, more than two miles southeast of Town. It was originally established in 1884 and burials happened until 1954. The new cemetery, Crescent Road Cemetery, was established later in 1911, at NW 23-24-22 W2, west of Strasbourg. Eight people were transferred from the Old Strassburg Cemetery to Crescent Road Cemetery. The oldest transfer burial from the Old Strassburg Cemetery is from 1889.

Crescent Road Cemetery garnered its name in 1926, whereby Council held a naming contest and the winner would receive \$5.00. "Crescent Road Cemetery" was chosen and four different entries split the prize money.

There are currently 1,283 people buried in Crescent Road Cemetery with 209 plots being reserved. Of the 1,283 burials, 1,028 are full burials and 255 are cremations.

DID YOU KNOW CONTINUED...

The Town has purchased a 48 niche columbarium that will be installed in the Cemetery in the spring of 2027. The niches are pre-selling for \$2,000.00 each. A niche holds up to two urns and the niches are 12.5" wide x 12.5" high and 14" deep. The price includes a standard bronze plaque and the opening and closing of the niche.



Due to rising maintenance costs, the fees for the cemetery will be increasing in September, including the plot price and the burial rates. It should also go without saying, but all burials are to be handled by the Town of Strasbourg. Individuals are not permitted to bury loved ones on their own. Burials through the Town Office ensures proper placement of the urn or casket, as well as keeps our Cemetery records accurate.

The Town is actively working on digitizing our cemetery records and map into a format that will be easily accessible on our website. It will make choosing plots, as well as doing genealogical research, much easier for everyone. The Town is aiming to have the work completed and available online by this winter.

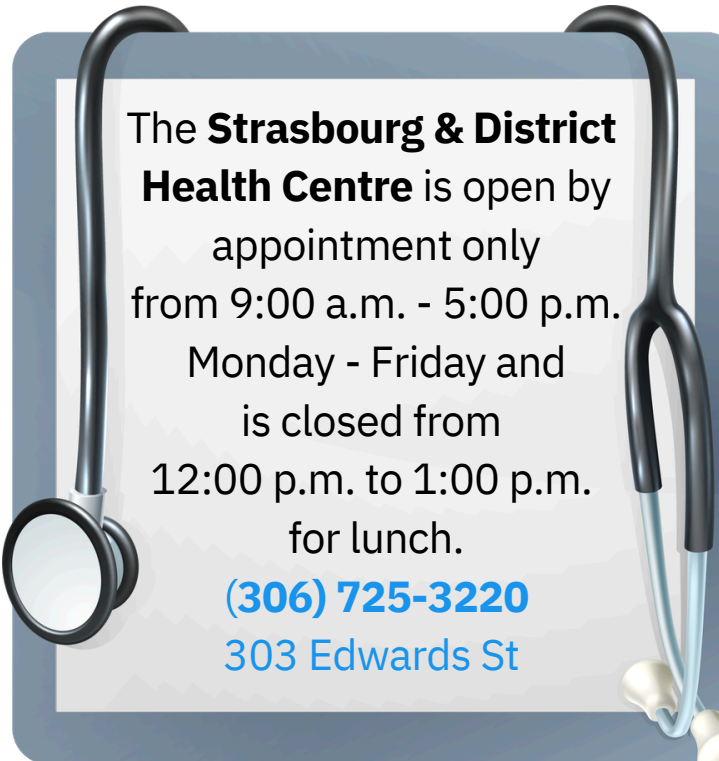
